DRIVERS ENTRY

- 1. **DRIVERS MUST BE 18 YEARS OF AGE** and have a valid driver's license in their possession. (16 years of age with a notarized parental medical statement obtained from Stoney Roberts Headquarters)
- 2. **ALL DRIVERS MUST SUPPLY THEIR OWN VEHICLES.** You are permitted One Six Cylinder Auto or One Eight Cylinder Auto.
- 3. **PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN A RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT BEFORE ENTERING ANY RESTRICTED AREA.**
- 4. **Entry Fee \$15.00 Cash or Money order.**

PARTICIPATION REGULATIONS

- 1. **6 & 8 Cyl. will compete in a specialty heat.** They will have their own **\$500.00 Cash purse.** Vehicles must maintain their O M E (Original Manufactured Equipment)
- 2. Most important rule you can take away anything you want from the vehicle. You just can not add any thing that was not on the vehicle when it was manufacture. You may move the battery & the gas tank.
- 3. **ALL GLASS AND CHROME TRIM,** and anything that might become imbedded in the track, must be removed (Stripped) from the car before bringing to the grounds. Do not leave broken glass in doors, clean and vacuum all doors out. **WINDSHIELDS MUST BE REMOVED.**
- 4. **TIRES MUST BE STOCK SIZE O M E,** 4 plies only, Tires can only be filled with air, no fluids or solids. (Tires within a tire are considered reinforcements) (tires marked tubeless may have tubes inserted in them) Remove all wheels balance weights inside & out.
- 5. **A MAXIMUM OF FIVE (5) GALLONS OF GASOLINE WILL BE ALLOWED. GAS TANKS** **No Original Gas tanks will be allowed in the drivers compartments.** If a substitute fuel cell or gas tank is in drivers, compartment the tanks must be **completely** covered by a **Metal** firewall. If gas tanks are located **in front of the rear axle,** they can be left in place but should be covered with a **skid plate** (between ground and tank) to prevent them from being damaged from the ground side. Only unleaded gasoline with a maximum octane level of 93 will be permitted. **BOOSTED** or **RACING FUEL** will not be allowed. If you have a vehicle equipped with a fuel pump in the gas tank, you must install an emergency cut off switch upon the dash with a red circle painted around it. No fuel pumps will be allowed within the driver's compartment. If you run gas lines in the drivers, compartments they must be double lined & double clamped. (A fuel line within another line.)
- 6. **ONLY ONE (1) STOCK BATTERY** will be allowed. A maximum of 1000 cold cranking amps will be permitted. Do not place them in the drivers street.
- 7. **NO REINFORCEMENTS OF ANY KIND WILL BE ALLOWED.** Only exception will be the driver side front door. IT is recommended that the driver's side door be reinforced with steel bar / angle iron / or pipe with tapered ends. Lengths not to extend past 8 inches on either side of doors vertical seam. It is suggested to pad drivers' side doors by using the back seat wedge between the driver and the driver's door., Rig a head rest or padding behind drivers' seat to protect the driver from whip lash.. Bolt & Chain all other doors up to six points. Also Bolt & Chain the Hood and trunk lids with Chain and Bolts up to six points.
- 8. **A 12 BY 15 INCH HOLE** must be cut into the center of hoods to allow for early fire detection.
- 9. **PRIOR TO BRINGING CARS TO FAIRGROUND** radiators must be drained and back flushed of all antifreeze coolants. They then can be refilled with water or the new naturally biodegradable animal friendly coolant. Disconnect & discharge all **Air Bag** Systems. Disconnect, discharge & remove all air conditioning refrigerant systems.
- 10. **SAFETY BELTS, HELMETS, AND IMPACT RESISTANT EYE PROTECTORS** are required. If the car was equipped with a shoulder restraint system including lap belts, use both. Drivers can be disqualified at any time if either belt or helmet is removed during a heat. Long sleeve-shirts & pants should be worn. You should consider wearing fire retardant clothing.
- 11. **ADDITIONAL SAFETY REGULATIONS** MAY BE IMPOSED depending on the track. Rules are subject to change to fit the event. If you have any safety concerns, Call 1-865-382-1955. Just because it is not stated in the rules does not make it allowable. If You have Doubts or Questions call. |
